Lucy Guerin Inc is an Australian dance company established in Melbourne in 2002 to create and perform new dance works. Renowned for the skill and quality of its small group of performers, it is a performance organisation dedicated to challenging and extending the art of contemporary dance. The company is committed to the exploration of everyday life and the redefinition of the formal concerns of dance. New productions are generated through an experimental approach to creative process, and may include voice, video, sound, text and industrial design as well as Guerin's lucid physical structures. Crucially, the company always a choreographic exploration, striving for emotional and physical revelations that are not generated or communicated in any other way than dance.

Lucy Guerin Inc has been a major influence on the development of Australian dance, which stems from the company's programmatic research into choreographic practice supported through several initiatives. *Pieces for Small Spaces* is its annual program for new dance works by emerging choreographers in Melbourne. *First Run* provides an opportunity for artists to share their current work through studio showings of first-draft pieces. The company also offers workshops with local international artists, presents one-off special events and maintains an artist-in-residence and development program.
